

TO BE READ AFTER THE POST COMMUNION PRAYER.

After communion, when all Eucharistic Ministers have come down from the sanctuary, the Commentator should take the lector's / cantor's seat next to the credence table, and open the Commentator's binder to the announcements page. After the Priest has read the Prayer after Communion, the commentator proceeds immediately to the ambo and starts to read the announcements.

- We begin the holy season of Lent on February 14, Ash Wednesday. Please see the bulletin today for the schedule of masses and services where the ashes will be distributed. You will also find the 2018 Lenten Regulations from the Office of Worship of the Diocese of Sacramento.
