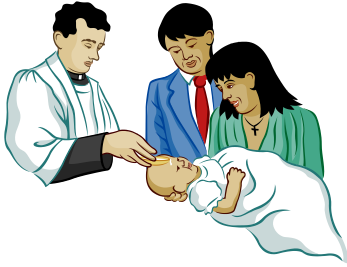

BAPTISM GUIDELINES

- Baptisms are performed at St. Clare for current members of our parish or those who have permission from their home parish pastor.
- These guidelines apply to children who are infants to under 7 years of age. For children 7 years of age through 5th grades, please contact the Holli Devereux at 772-4717, ext. 113. For children 6th through 12th grades, please contact Tim Rumery at 772-4717, ext. 118.
- Baptisms are performed on the 3rd Sunday of every month in the afternoon. There will usually be a small group of children to be baptized at the same time as your child. We try to make the Baptism Rite as personal as possible.
- Your family must be registered at St. Clare to have your child baptized. You can obtain the Parish Registration and the Baptism Registration forms in the Parish Office during the week, in the narthex of the church as you enter for weekend masses or through the link at the bottom of this page. We can also mail or fax the forms to you.
- Please complete the form and at the Parish Office, fax it to 916-772-4152, or deposit in one of the collection baskets at the weekend Masses. The Baptism Coordinator will call you within a week to set up the date and time.
- There is a mandatory Baptism Preparation Class for parents. The class lasts about 1 hour and a half. It usually takes place on the 2nd Saturday of every month at 3:00 PM. Children to be baptized are to attend with their parents.
- At least 1 parent and 1 godparent must be a practicing Catholic. At least 1 godparent must be Confirmed and over the age of 16. And at least 1 godparent must either 1) attend a Baptism Preparation Class, either at St. Clare or any other parish, or 2) provide a letter of “Good Standing” from their home parish pastor. The 2nd godparent does not have to be Catholic, but must be of a Christian faith recognized by the Catholic Church.
- A child can have any number of godparents, however there must be at least one male and one female. Only 2 godparents can be named on the baptismal certificate. Additional godparents are included in the original baptism record.
- If a godparent cannot attend the baptism, a proxy may stand in for them.
- A donation that supports our Church, usually \$50, can be given at the time of the Baptism or Prep Class, dropped in the regular collection basket at mass or brought to the Parish Office. Please make sure the envelope is clearly marked “Baptism Donation.”
